

Arriving at NIH:

The NIH campus is accessible by taxi/ride-share, personal vehicle, or public transportation. A map of the NIH campus can be found at this website: <u>NIH Visitor Map</u>. Please plan to <u>add at least 45 minutes to</u> **your travel** to accommodate NIH security procedures.

Taxi/ride-share: Services such as taxis, Uber, or Lyft are encouraged due to the limited parking and current construction at NIH. The best location for drop-off is the Medical Center station Kiss and Ride. Upon drop-off, enter through the **NIH Gateway Center** to receive your visitor badge.

Personal vehicle: Visitors arriving in personal vehicles must park in designated visitor parking lots/garages. The nearest parking garage to the event is the NIH Visitor Gateway Parking Garage (MLP-11). The cost to park in MLP-11 is \$2 per hour for the first three hours, \$12 maximum for the entire day. After parking your vehicle, proceed to the **NIH Gateway Center** to receive your visitor badge.

Public transportation (Metro): Take the Red Line to Medical Center station. Exit the station and proceed to the **NIH Gateway Center** to receive your visitor badge.

Security Screening:

All visitors should proceed to the **NIH Gateway Center** to undergo security screening and obtain a visitor badge. Please bring a valid government-issued ID and the information listed below to expedite security screening.

Getting to Lipsett Amphitheater:

Upon receiving your visitor badge, you may choose to walk on your own to the NIH Clinical Center (Building 10) or ride an NIH shuttle bus. You may board the shuttle at the Metro stop, just outside of the Gateway Center. The following shuttle routes will stop at the Building 10 Main (North) entrance:

- NIH Campus
- NIH Campus Limited
- CC Special Event
