The purpose of the Strategic Plan is to focus, coordinate, and accelerate high quality research and scientific discovery to answer the urgent questions and needs of ASD individuals and families.



Draft Goals

WHEN should I be concerned about my child's development? All children with ASD will be identified at an early age and receive appropriate care appropriate to diagnosis **HOW** can I understand what is happening with my child? Understanding how ASD affects development with lead to targeted and personalized treatments **WHAT** caused this to happen and how can this be prevented? Causes of ASD with be discovered that lead to prevention/preemption of ASD WHERE can I turn for services? Communities will establish coordinated, high quality and cost effective ASD services across the lifespan **WHAT** does the future hold? Advances in treatment and public understanding will enable all people on the autism spectrum to lead fulfilling and productive lives in the community

- Sense of Urgency We will focus on what steps we can take now to be responsive to the needs of individuals and families affected by ASD.
- Spirit of Collaboration We will treat others with respect, listen to diverse views with open minds, and foster discussions where participants can comfortable offer opposing opinions.
- **Consumer-focused** We will focus on making a difference in the lives of people affected by ASD, including individuals with ASD, their families, medical practitioners, educators, and scientists.

- Excellence We will pursue basic and clinical research of the highest quality to protect the safety and advance the best interests of those affected by ASD.
- Partnerships in Action We will value crossdisciplinary approaches, data sharing, teamwork, and partnerships with clearly defined roles and responsibilities.
- Accountability We will develop SMART (specific, measurable, achievable, realistic, and time-bound) research objectives aligned with funding priorities and develop systems for evaluation and course corrections.

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
