IACC Responsibilities


• Combating Autism Act of 2006 (Public Law 109-416 SEC. 399CC.(b)(5))

"develop and <u>annually update</u> a strategic plan for the conduct of, and support for, autism spectrum disorder research, including proposed budgetary requirements"

Annual Updating of the IACC Strategic Plan for ASD Research – Draft Cycle

IACC will need to develop processes to:

- Monitor Progress
 - Identify & gather from funders input on the status of objectives
 - Identify & gather stakeholder views on progress
- Identify Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Gaps (SWOG)
 - Identify & gather stakeholder views on SWOG

• Analyze Information

- Consider progress to date and SWOG to develop changes to the plan
- Revise the IACC Strategic Plan
 - Make specific edits to the plan, including revisions to the objectives and cost estimates



IACC Decisions Needed Today

- Are these 4-steps for updating acceptable?
 - Monitor progress
 - Identify SWOG
 - Analyze information
 - Revise plan and budget estimates

- Work Group or Meeting

• What will be the charge?

- Develop processes for the IACC to follow annually to:
