- 1. What safety concerns are the most urgent for people with ASD and their families?
- 2. What are your top three concerns related to keeping your child <u>or adult son/daughter with ASD</u> safe?

Comment [DHHS1]: What demographic information will be collected from the respondents? It would be helpful to have a sense of age and gender of family member with autism, whether family member lives at home, and geographic distribution (state, urban vs rural)

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- 3. What are your top three concerns related to keeping your other family members safe?
- 4. What situations or settings in your community have been particularly challenging to manage safety concerns?
- 5. Have your concerns changed as your child <u>or adult</u> <u>son/daughter with ASD</u> has gotten older? <u>In what way?</u>
- 6. Have you or <u>any member of your family ever felt</u>
 <u>seriously physically threatened by your child or adult</u>
 <u>son/daughter with ASD? How often has this</u>
 occurred?
- 7. What resources would be helpful to you to keep your child <u>or adult/son daughter with ASD</u> and your family safe?
