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
#### **IACC Upcoming Report to Congress (FY 2010- FY 2012)**

Expected submission to Congress and release in 2014


### ACCUpcoming Portfolio Analysis Report (2011-2012)

- Expected release in 2014


# **IACC Summary of Advances**

  - Lifespan issues

- Nomina OARC compiles nominations into ballot for IACC vote
